## **BAHA Student Expectations Agreement**

BAHA operates on a system of respect. Whether it is directed from one student to another, toward the facility we use, in the classroom towards the teacher, or in the classroom with effort and attitude; Each student must agree to the following list of expectations and guidelines in order to be a part of the BAHA program. If at any time one or more of this checklist is violated, BAHA will take correctional and disciplinary measures, that if not resolved, could ultimately result in the student no longer being able to participate in BAHA classes. Please read the following carefully, initial and sign.

I understand that at BAHAI am expected to participate in my classes; this includes: turning assignments in, being prepared for class, and having an overall positive and engaging attitude in the classroom.
I understand that my words and actions while at BAHA need to be kind and respectful. This includes how I speak to other students, how I speak to teachers, and how I speak to Study Hall Supervisors. No threatening or inappropriate conversations are permitted. No bullying of any kind will be tolerated.
I understand that I need to respect the property of others including the facility of Fellowship Bible Church. This means, I need to pick up after myself trying to always leave the place I was sitting better than when I found it. No writing on walls or tables, no rough housing, no standing or walking on items not intended for that purpose, no wandalism of any kind.
I understand that weapons of any kind, including pocket- knives, are not allowed on campus. I also understand that talking about weapons, even as a joke, is not appropriate and will not be allowed.
I understand that my clothes need to be appropriate and in line with the BAHA standards of dress code: No skirts, dresses, or shorts that are above finger-tip length; No hole-y jeans with holes above finger-tip length. Cropped tops exposing mid-drift, low cut or tight fitted shirts for girls are not allowed and any clothing, bags, or other items with vulgar or violent images on them are not allowed. <i>Shoes are required in class and in Study Hall.</i>
