The "Who Will Teach Them?" program began in 2005. The program is designed to build PHILLIPS' organizational capacity to help children in an increasingly professional manner. The fund covers two major areas: professional development with a focus on recruitment and retention, and educational opportunities to the community at large with a focus on PHILLIPS' specialized expertise.

The "Who Will Teach Them?" fund is used by staff to allow participation in multiple resources including:

- Attending educational conferences and seminars;
- Continuing education and certification classes;
- Leadership Development Program; and
- Program Directors receive money to initiate new programs that focus primarily on staff development.
