"From the Bible an individual can learn a lot about God and can even come to know God. That **can** be done alone. But, in community, in the Church, when with the people of God, you can go deeper into the Bible and the Bible can go deeper into you in a way that can never happen if left to yourself. Corporate worship and prayer are the same, they connect you and grow you in ways that personal worship and prayer cannot.

If you say or think "I'll just get the sermon online, I can listen on my own in my car, I can watch the service later and get the same thing from them, I don't have to go to church, and I'll be just as shaped by them as if I was there"or even if you say "I'll go to church every once in a while, but I won't join the church, I won't make covenant with them to be a member of the community in which everyone vows their commitment to helping one another grow, and I can be just as healthy and grow just as much...you are wrong! You are wrong! And the reasons that is wrong are not psychological or sociological. They are theological. God's promise to 'dwell with' and have 'visiting presence' with his people was with his gathered, corporate, covenant people.

 - A. Union with Christ (Identity, Washing, Newness)
 - B. Communion with the Triune God (Father, Son and Holy Spirit)
 - **C.** A True Community (Covenant relationship with God and His People)

But, what of those who do NOT Belong?

- III. Those who Believe, Belong and are "BEING BUILT UP" vs. 5
 - A. Into a "Spiritual House" (Not individual houses, but a single House of Praise)
 - B. As a "Priesthood" (Not individual priests, but a collective Priesthood)

1 Peter 2:4-10

4 As you come to him, the living Stone—rejected by humans but chosen by God and precious to him— 5 you also, like living stones, are being built into a spiritual house to be a holy priesthood, offering spiritual sacrifices acceptable to God through Jesus Christ. 6 For in Scripture it says:

"See, I lay a stone in Zion, a chosen and precious cornerstone, and the one who trusts in him will never be put to shame."

7 Now to you who believe, this stone is precious. But to those who do not believe,

"The stone the builders rejected has become the cornerstone,"

8 and.

"A stone that causes people to stumble and a rock that makes them fall."

They stumble because they disobey the message—which is also what they were destined for. 9 But you are a chosen people, a royal priesthood, a holy nation, God's special possession, that you may declare the praises of him who called you out of darkness into his wonderful light. 10 Once you were not a people, but now you are the people of God; once you had not received mercy, but now you have received mercy.
