

## OUTPATIENT NEUROPSYCHOLOGY SERVICES

The purpose of Outpatient Neuropsychology Services is to provide neuropsychological assessment and recommendations to clients living with neurological conditions or to clients querying cognitive impairments from as yet undiagnosed conditions (e.g., mild cognitive impairment, ADHD, learning disability).

### Admission Criteria:

- Client must be minimum 16 years of age and a resident of Northwestern Ontario.
- The client has a neurological diagnosis (e.g., Stroke, Acquired Brain Injury, Multiple Sclerosis) or the referral source is querying cognitive impairment not yet diagnosed.
- Client requires neuropsychological assessment that is not otherwise accessible by any other means (i.e., Forensics, Workplace Safety and Insurance Board, Motor Vehicle Accident Benefits).
- Client is able to actively participate in assessment for the duration of an assessment period (most often 4 hours minimum).
- Independent with toileting or have a caregiver to attend and assist.

### Service Process:

- Clients undergo a clinical interview with the Neuropsychologist.
- Clients complete neuropsychological testing with the Psychometric Technician for up to six hours.
- A report is prepared by the Neuropsychologist and the client is offered a feedback appointment to review findings and recommendations prior to the report being distributed.
