SIMPLE TIPS FOR A GREAT HIKE

SAFTEY FIRST. BE NICE TO OTHERS SECOND. Safety's great, but are you polite? Do you care about other hikers and wildlife? How do you show it? Good hiking etiquette ensures that everyone on the trail has a good time, from beginners to seasoned hikers. And say hi to your fellow hikers and be sure to warm them of any dangers ahead, they will appricate your kindness.

KNOW THE RIGHT OF WAY Remember to know when you do and don't have the right of way. On multi-use trails, people on horseback or bicycles have the right of way. People walking uphill also have the right of way over those going downhill. Keep to the right side of the trail to allow passing on your left. Be aware of your surroundings and notice if someone is trying to pass you. Politely let someone know if you will be passing them.

WHEN HIKING WITH A DOG, bring a leash and enough water, and make sure your pet is wearing an ID collar. Always pick up after your dog, please!

CLEAN AS YOU GO. Pick up trash along the trail. Many hikers bring a bagalong to pick up garbage. There are several trash cans along these trails. Give back and take pride in your favorite trails. Report significant trash or vandalism to the Narrowsburg Beautification Group.

PERMITS PLEASE. Don't fish or hunt unless you have a permit. In many areas, this is illegal.

TRAIL INFO

TOTAL ROUND TRIP DISTANCE IS 2 5MILES

DE MAURO TRAIL: 5 Miles, along unlit rural lane, mostly level turrain with one moderate hill.

MAIN ST. HISTORIC DISTRICT TRAIL: 1 Mile. business and cultural district, mostly level terrain with one moderate hill.

RIVER FLATS TRAIL: 1 Mile, residential district along the Delaware River, level terrain. Please respect resident's privacy.



TRAIL MARKER: Stay on marked trails.



TRAIL MILE MARKER: The trail mileage sign shows the distance from the trail head and (from start of current trail).


