What is the NCCEP/GEAR UP Capacity-Building Workshop (CBW)?

The NCCEP/GEAR UP Capacity-Building Workshop is designed to develop the skills, knowledge, and practices of GEAR UP leaders, practitioners, and partners. Each day begins with a thought-provoking and energizing “Burst” keynote session that will underscore one of our EXCEL/PROVE/MOBILIZE strategies. The remainder of each day is followed by intensive workshops focused on cross-cutting skills, a slate of shorter seminars focused on best practices, and ample networking time with your team and colleagues from across the nation. The combination of leadership development skills and topical seminars will help advance your programmatic success and expand your growth as a GEAR UP leader and change agent.

How do I register?

How much is registration and what does a registration cover?

Member registration is \$475 for the complete 3-day event. Non-member registration is \$575. Registration covers online access to the Capacity-Building Workshop and all of the sessions, networking opportunities, and the Exhibit Hall. Earn additional discounts by registering as a group. If you register 10 or more individuals at once, each individual's registration fee will be discounted by \$25. And don't worry. If your schedule is complicated during the event, registrants will be able to access recordings of each and every session anytime over the next year.

Can we pay for registration with a check?
