What is the College Success Learning Lab?

The College Success Learning Lab (CSLL) is an eleven-week learning experience which recognizes that the first year of college is a critical time for any student. A Learning Lab is a blended professional development model that combines online courses with facilitated live virtual sessions for a cohort of learners.

In the CSLL, GEAR UP advisors will learn strategies and techniques to help students thrive in the first year of college, setting them up to successfully complete a college degree. Key topics include how to work toward a degree in a timely manner, how to navigate employability and financial aid, and how to handle situations that students may be facing for the first time. Participants will walk away with an understanding of the GEAR UP College Advising Framework and Bottom Line's DEAL Model for college success.

Who is it for?

GEAR UP professionals who:

- Work with late high school students or college freshman.
- Advise students on college success topics, including academics and finances.
- Provide direct student services.
- Have the support of their supervisor.

What can it help participants accomplish?

By participating, participants will:

- Gain strategies and techniques to help students succeed in college.
- Build a national network to aid in learning and development.
- Create tools to advise students to and through the first year of college.





PROGRAM FEATURES & REQUIREMENTS FOR COMPLETION

During the CSLL, participants can expect to spend 2-4 hours each week completing online courses and/or participating in a live virtual session. To demonstrate what they have learned, participants will submit a completed Participant Guide as their final project.

ONLINE COURSES

To become familiar with specific college advising strategies, participants will complete 5 courses. Topics include the GEAR UP College Advising Framework, Transitions, Degree, Employability, Affordability, and Life.

**To receive a Certificate of Completion, participants must pass assessments for all courses.*

LIVE VIRTUAL SESSIONS

Every week, participants will meet with each other to discuss what they learned while taking the most recent course. Instructors will guide activities to deepen learning and reinforce concepts. Participants will strategize how to put what they learned into action. After each call, instructors will stay on for 30-minutes of optional *Office Hours*.

**To receive a Certificate of Completion, participants must attend 5 of the 6 sessions, with Calls #1 and #6 required.*

FINAL PROJECT

As participants complete online courses, they will engage in exercises to practice what they are learning via a Participant Guide. At the end of the Learning Lab, participants will submit their completed Participant Guide and a reflection as evidence of what they learned and how they will use it.

**To receive a Certificate of Completion, participants must submit the final project.*

NETWORKING

The cohort gets a space to network. This includes touchpoints to connect with one another, opportunities aligned to other NCCEP/GEAR UP programs, and a place for participants to connect with each other.

**To receive a Certificate of Completion, participants will need to complete these program requirements. If a participant is unable to fulfill all of the program requirements, they will receive a Certificate of Participation.*
