essence of their own favourite artists. Andy Warhol's Flowers series is echoed in the metal and red gesso decoration of Kate Noakes' Poppy cabinet (£3,000). And one homeowner commissioned Dublinbased design duo Susan Zelouf and Michael Bell to translate her love of Mark Rothko's paintings and Japanese motifs into the exotic Kimono cabinet (€83,500), whose dramatically deep tones were achieved with car paint. Meanwhile, Sean Scully, the Dublin-born, New York-based artist and Turner Prize nominee, inspired Zelouf +Bell's Scullied drinks cabinet (€11,370). Its painterly façade references Scully's abstract Wall of Light series, employing a palette of dyed wood veneers in various depths to mirror his thickly layered paints. Exploring further synergies with contemporary art, Zelouf +Bell integrated a back-lit stained-glass panel portraying a black and white skyline by artist Peadar Lamb (a descendant of pre-Raphaelite Ford Madox Brown) within the elegantly curved, wall-mounted Nighttown cabinet (\$20,960).

Just as abstract art embraces bold graphics, so does storage. Parisian graphic designers Antoine Audiau and Manuel Warosz (Antoine +Manuel) gave BD Barcelona Design's Tout Va Bien cabinet (€7,420) an intriguing relief pattern of hieroglyphics and contemporary
