We will start with the team theory exam at the end of the day Friday and move into our Championship tests and team rides throughout the weekend.. Held annually in the northern and southern regions of the California Dressage Society, the championships are specifically held in honor of our youngest members and was the brain-child of CDS Volunteer of the Year Trip Harting and Mary Schrader. The CDS Junior/Young Rider Championship is the largest and longest run show of its type in the nation.

Our CDS Junior/Young Rider programs have a long history of supporting our youth in equestrian sport. Through the Club 100 scholarship program, funds are available for every CDS junior/young rider member. Annually, there are CDS scholarships available for CDS members under 21 years, and we host two regional clinics allowing each CDS chapter to send a junior/young rider representative to an instructional clinic. We are constantly looking to meet the needs of our junior/young rider members including reviewing the traditional elements of a championship show environment. We offer Team competitions to bring a sports team environment to our individual sport! We offer a jog-skills test and freestyle combined with the Championship tests to create an overall level champion. 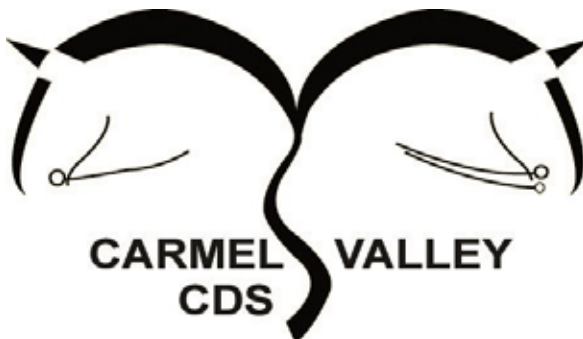

THE OFFICIALS

CARA WHITHAM (S)

Cara is an FEI "O" Dressage judge, Equine and US Equestrian Senior dressage judge. Her dressage officiating includes CDIO Aachen and CDIs in England, Italy, Australia, Germany and Uruguay, numerous CDIs in USA and Canada, including both countries' World Cup League Finals.

An all-around horsewoman, Cara has competed very successfully in Dressage, Eventing and Jumping. Five times National Champion including Canadian National Grand Prix and Freestyle Championships.



REBECCA LEWIS TD-R

Rebecca comes to us from Sonoma County. She is a 'R' Dressage Technical Delegate. She began officiating as a TD in 1995. In 2003, she officiated at her first CDI, The Golden State, in April. She officiated at the Region 7 Championships in 1997 and 1999 and has worked in such sufferable places as Oahu, Hawaii and the San Diego area, enjoying the travel. She is a Juvenile Probation Officer in "real" life and enjoys wine tasting, sailing on San Francisco Bay, putting on the driving range, and other outdoor activities. She has been a board member of the Sonoma Chapter of the California Dressage Society, as well as a committee head of Dressage in the Wine Country since the early 1990s.



CHARLOTTE TRENTLEMAN (S)

Charlotte Trentelman is a USEF "S" Dressage Judge who has achieved the USDF Bronze and Silver Medals. She has competed thru Grand Prix. She served as USDF Region 3's Director for two terms. She is currently a member of USDF's Historical Committee.

She was one of the original planners of USDF's National Symposium and served as the local organizer for the Symposium for its first five years at Grand Cypress Equestrian Center in Orlando, Florida. She participated in all 9 Region 3 Instructor Seminars with Major Anders Lindgren—starting as a demo rider and, finally, organizing and hosting. She has participated in numerous USDF Instructor Trainer clinics, both as demo rider and instructor.

A dressage competitor since 1976, she has competed with Arabs, Quarter Horses, Thoroughbreds, Warmbloods, Morgans, and Andalusians.

She has held a USEF judge's card since 1992, achieving her "S" status in 2003. She has judged breed National Championships, USDF Regional Championships, and, twice, National Dressage Seat Championships.

Charlotte and her husband, Chris, own Rebel Ridge Farm in Anthony, FL, near Ocala. Rebel Ridge is a teaching and training facility which has hosted many local, national and international clinicians. When she's not judging or competing in Dressage, she also competes in Combined Driving Events at the Advanced level with her first pony, a Haflinger named Mary.



NICO MEREDITH- Announcer

Born in the United Kingdom, Nicho was educated in the private school system in England. He spent five years in Europe at language schools, including the University of Salzburg and five years in a cavalry regiment of the British Army.

Nicho has ridden all of his life, mainly for pleasure and fox hunting. His only competitive event was the "Saumur Cup" (a prestigious Reserve Army Trophy) in which he competed for four straight years.

He has announced in England at Horse Trials since the age of 18 and has announced at all of the main European Championships. In 1986 he worked at the FEI in Bern, Switzerland, with special responsibilities to the three-day events, sponsorship and public relations. In 1990 Nicho came to the USA to announce and install sound systems at equestrian events and venues.


His talents include being multilingual, with the ability to announce in 13 different languages. He was the interpreter for the British three day event team at the European Championships in 1973.




HEATHER STALKER (R)

Heather is a USEF R dressage judge and USDF gold medalist. She also holds an R judging license for western dressage. She lives in Alachua, FL with her wife, Greta Wrigley, her horses, dogs, cats and chickens. She has been honored to judge the Caribbean Dressage Challenge, the Morgan Grand Nationals, Arabian Sport Horse Nationals and the National Dressage Pony Cup. She is looking forward to seeing fresh and talented new faces at the CDS JR/YR Championships and wishes all of the competitors great rides.







Mary Schrader has a long history with the Junior Championships. In 1988 when Trip Harting suggested CDS create a special championship just for juniors, Mary was the first to step forward and make it a reality. In honor of Mary, in 2012, the show created a special championship class for juniors and young riders riding at the Prix St Georges level. Riders are to ride two Prix St Georges tests, one in a snaffle bridle and one in a double bridle and the winner receives the Mary Schrader Challenge Trophy.

Children Are Our Greatest Resources

By Trip Harting – Dressage Letters June 1988

Years ago when I was living in Hawaii, the Board of Governors of the Hawaii Horse Shows Association and the riding community at large faced an almost devastating problem to the future of horseback riding in the islands. There were virtually no young riders competing in the horse shows – despite the fact that my riding school and several others had a large number of children and teenagers as students! If the standard and interest in horseback riding were to grow and continue in the State of Hawaii, something had to be done and quickly.

The problem was quite obvious, as was the solution. At the time, horse show management offered only the usual standard of classes – regular working hunter and the usual equitation classes. Classes were always well filled. The problem was that if a young rider entered any one of these classes, he competed against all the professionals, adults and recent graduates of the equitation division. So why bother? The only classes they had a chance in were the equitation classes for those under 18 and those were always won by the 18 year olds. As a result of this situation, interest in riding and competing waned horribly over the years.

The solution was handled by establishing full-on divisions for children and young riders – classes in which they competed amongst their peers and if they wanted to compete against the adults, they could enter the regular open classes. The results of this decision exceeded everyone's wildest dreams. The Junior Divisions are now hotly contested and the residual effect is being felt in the open classes. These young riders now have the chance to develop their skills and confidence in an environment that encourages growth rather than discourages it.

We, in California, are faced with exactly the same problem. There is absolutely no difference. Just pick up a program at any dressage show or look at your 1988 Omnibus and see how many classes are offered to our children. If dressage is to continue to grow and develop in the country, it becomes mandatory that we develop and encourage the children of today. How much trouble would it be to offer a second section in all classes for the young riders only? Section A could be open to all riders; section B for young riders only. The extra few dollars it would cost for trophy and ribbons would pale in the long-term end results of such a practice. If worried about the added costs, the section could be sponsored.

Regardless, we have little choice in the matter. If we don't encourage our young riders of today, we will never become a factor in the international scene – pure and simple.

We of the dressage community must offer classes at all levels open strictly to those under 18. It is not enough to offer only the official Young Rider Tests, although this helps. We must develop the skills at an early age and that begins with a few children riding against each other at Training Level Test One and continues through each level over the years to competing against each other at the Grand Prix in the Olympic Games.

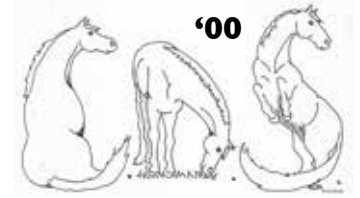
The kids are out there – in the Pony Clubs, on the Eventing circuit and riding over tiny courses in the hunter/jumper shows. Dressage competitions are run by adults and are sponsored by adults for adults. But this is not and cannot afford to be strictly an adult sport.

I believe that CDS has an obligation to the dressage community to offer, promote and develop a strong and active young rider division. This could be done by offering a Young Rider Championship with qualifying classes exactly as they are offered to the adults. This would encourage show management to offer these classes in their shows and would ultimately play an enormous role in developing the future of the sport. To do anything less would be criminal.

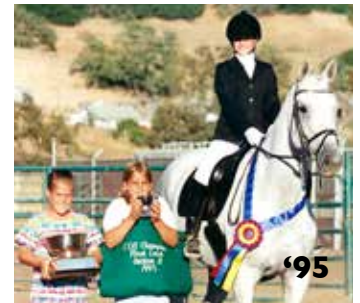
