

Directions to
Tusawilla Cabin – Micanopy
owned by
Alachua Conservation Trust

*Tusawilla Cabin is just southeast of Micanopy,
with an address of approximately 211 SE Tusawilla Road.*

From Gainesville on US 441: Go south to the flashing light at the intersection of CR 234 (at “The Pearl”) in Micanopy. Turn right onto NE Cholokka Blvd, which is the main street of downtown Micanopy and go south all the way through town, a distance of approximately ½ mile. The road swings to the left (easterly), becoming SE Tusawilla Road (aka SE 165th Avenue or CR 25A). Go a little more than 1/10th of a mile, over a set of speed bumps, and the driveway is a small dirt lane on your right, just past a paved driveway. Take this dirt driveway, which has an open metal gate and a sign "209" straight south about 2/10 of a mile, past two houses on your right, through another gate and over a narrow wooden bridge to the Tusawilla Cabin.

From Gainesville on I-75: Go south to the Micanopy exit # 374, and turn left, heading east and north on CR 234 towards Micanopy. Turn right into onto NW Seminary Avenue, and head east into historic Micanopy. At Cholokka Blvd, take a right, and almost immediately the street swings to the left (easterly), becoming SE Tusawilla Road (aka SE 165th Avenue or CR 25A). Go a little more than 1/10th of a mile, over a set of speed bumps, and the driveway is a small dirt lane on your right, just past a paved driveway. Take this dirt driveway, which has an open metal gate and a sign "209" straight south about 2/10 of a mile, past two houses on your right, through another gate and over a narrow wooden bridge to the Tusawilla Cabin.
