



A Quick Story of the Power of In Her Shoes Foundation

A beautiful 7th grade girl: Not being able to share her struggles at home because her mother has "too much on her plate," hiding her battle with anorexia, needing control but not knowing how to get it and a part of the RSGA Program. She was able to share her struggles with body image, engaging in self-harm as a result of being bullied, with our RSGA group mentor - because she's comfortable and put at ease. And, together, they start for journey to find strength and courage to navigate her way but the darkness. And her life is changed for the better.

READY SET GIRLS ACADEMY

Young women in today's society often struggle to deal with everyday pressures and expectations. Through the IHSF flagship program, **Ready Set Girls** Academy, we are giving girls the tools they need to navigate life's challenges in a positive way.

The IHSF RSGA program seeks to reach these vulnerable young women before crisis strikes and we seek to equip them with the tools they can use to help avoid and/or manage traumatic situations. Through our knowledge based curriculum, RSGA students gain knowledge and exposure to life skills and problem solving techniques not taught in the traditional public, private or charter school environments.

"I am so grateful for the skills I have learned and am now able to use in my everyday life. Through RSGA I've learned new coping skills, like how to communicate more effectively how to control my anger and even had a chance to polish up a few of my old ones. I've learned to agree to disagree. To speak up! Because my opinions matter! Without the outlet of RSGA, I wouldn't be as assertive and outspoken as I am today."

Topics Covered

Participants will meet 1-2x per week for 90-minute sessions. Professional women, who have the education credentials and leadership experience to bring these concepts home to teenage girls, facilitate the sessions each week.

Middle School

Ready Set Girls Academy for Middle School™ is a curriculum specifically created to meet the needs of girls ages 10-14.

The Ready Set Girls Leadership Academy focuses on 4 major areas of Exploration: Self Identity, Relationships, Mind and Body, and an optional Community Service unit. Listed here are examples of some of the different lessons created for the RSGA Middle School curriculum.

Self Identity

The Program

The curriculum is designed to provide participants with a safe and caring learning environment where they can learn the life skills that will allow them to excel in life.

The goal of this program is to give young girls the tools they need to explore who they are and who they want to become!

In each lesson we aim to improve their self-esteem and encourage them to reach for higher achievement. The program is free and available for high schools, middle schools, and community organizations. We provide all the materials and volunteer Group Mentors who run the program.

Topics

We make our lessons verv interactive. We find that the girls gain a lot from sharing their experiences and listening to each other. Our trained and experienced volunteer Group Mentors provide a safe and caring learning environment. They encourage the girls to discuss a different topic in each session.


The organization began as the Positive Girls Club in 2008 for women of all ages who were determined to make positive changes in their lives. Women came together to share positive thoughts, provide inspiration to each other and share self-improvement opportunities. The group began to slowly grow and gain momentum as a forum for women to build strong individual and community relationships. Positive Girls Club became a strong professional resource in the Chicagoland area.

In 2011, Positive Girls Club changed its name to In Her Shoes Foundation to better reflect the organization's core values and mission and was granted 501c3 status.

From the beginning and still today, the organization is run solely by volunteers.
