### Motus Theater COVID-19 Policies for In-Person Events *(The Show Doesn't Have to Go On - But **YOU** Do!)*

To take care of each other (performers, staff and community), Motus has established new pandemic-conscious policies. These policies are based on [CDC](#), [state](#), and [local government](#) guidelines as well as on the policies of leading arts and community organizations such as Cleo Parker Robinson Dance Studio, and the Denver Center for the Performing Arts. We appreciate your patience and flexibility as we grow and adapt together during this unprecedented time.

#### Staff & Volunteers

Motus staff and volunteers are required to be vaccinated, and to wear a mask at all times, with the exception of time spent onstage if they are speaking as part of the event. Proof of vaccination is required and can be presented one of three ways:

1. Physical copy of vaccination card
2. Photo of the front and back of card
3. The [MyColorado App](#) preloaded with your vaccination status.

Motus staff and volunteers experiencing [cold and/or flu symptoms](#) should stay home and communicate immediately with Motus about their health status by emailing Rita at [rita@motustheater.org](mailto:rita@motustheater.org).

All staff and volunteers assisting with front-of-house duties will be [trained to inspect and verify proof of vaccination](#) and [test results](#).

*Thank you for your support in taking care of each other as we figure out the best way to respond to COVID.*

#### Performers and Presenters

In order to perform/present at a Motus Theater in-person event you must have proof of vaccination or negative covid test.

Proof can be presented one of three ways:

1. Physical copy of vaccination card
2. Photo of the front and back of card
3. The [MyColorado App](#) preloaded with your vaccination status.

If you are not vaccinated, please bring proof of a negative COVID-19 PCR test (taken within 72 hours - more information on testing can be found [here](#); if your testing site can only provide you

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test results after 72 hours, please email Rita at [rita@motustheater.org](mailto:rita@motustheater.org)), or Motus can ship you an antigen/rapid test that you can do at your home within 6hrs of call time at the theater.

To take care of each other, we also require that everyone (performers, staff and audience) wear a face covering at all times, except performers and staff when presenting on stage or previously agreed upon situations such as specific warm-up and rehearsals.

Performers experiencing [cold and/or flu symptoms](#) should stay home and communicate immediately with Motus about their health status by emailing Rita at [rita@motustheater.org](mailto:rita@motustheater.org).

**NOTE:** If Motus Theater collaborates with a venue that does not require proof of COVID-19 vaccination and/or negative COVID-19 test for audiences, Motus Theater presenters will be informed in advance so they are aware of risk from the audience.

### Audience Members

In order to attend a Motus Theater performance, audience members 12 yrs of age and older must have proof of vaccination or negative covid test.

Proof can be presented one of three ways:

1. Physical copy of vaccination card
2. Photo of the front and back of card
3. The [MyColorado App](#) preloaded with your vaccination status.

If you are not vaccinated we ask that you bring proof of a negative COVID-19 PCR test (taken within 72 hours) or negative antigen (rapid) test (taken within 6 hours). More information on testing can be found [here](#).

To take care of each other we will also require that a face covering be worn by all audience members 5 yrs of age and older.

**NOTE:** When being produced by a venue, Motus will abide by the COVID-19 mitigation policies for audiences applied by the host venue. Instances in which Motus is abiding by a venue's COVID-19 mitigation policies for audience members will be clearly stated on the event's page on Motus Theater's website.

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
