


CROSS-BORDER GRANTING: WHAT WE WERE MADE FOR.

BEAUTY IN EVERY BANDAGE

As a missionary kid growing up in a remote village in Nigeria, Don Campion developed a lively sense of adventure from a young age. From hunting with villagers for days out in the bush, to driving a motorcycle across the Sahara Desert all the way to England, Don never dreamed his biggest adventure would happen as an adult—the quest to revitalize the once-thriving mission hospital his parents had worked so hard to establish.

Built in 1952 by his parents, Dr. George and Esther Campion, physician missionaries from Canada, Egbe Hospital had become a vital outpost for medical treatment serving Nigerians from all over the country. But by 2008, the facility had fallen into disrepair and was on the brink of closure. That's the heartbreaking reality that Don and his wife, Sueanne, discovered when they visited Egbe for the first time since Don had left Nigeria as a young adult.

Soon after that visit, a vision to breathe new life into Egbe began to form. And over the next 15 years, the Campions mobilized their resources and connections as owners of Banyan Air Service in Fort Lauderdale, FL to help lead the rebuilding of Egbe Hospital and College of Nursing. And TrustBridge Global has been an integral part of that effort.

"With TrustBridge's low grant fee and efficient international banking processes, we've seen a 30% gain on every gift," Don says. "We're so delighted because that means more money to the people who need it most."

Today, Egbe Medical Mission is a 50-acre medical complex and nursing school serving over 21,000 patients a year within a 100-mile radius of small villages and towns who come for life-saving surgeries and compassionate faith-based medical care.
