

Collections

The Broadway Green Alliance collects and sends items to its partners for upcycling, recycling and/or safe disposal.

TerraCycle® Programs

The BGA and TerraCycle® have teamed up to collect the following:

Bausch + Lomb® Contact Lenses Program

All brands of new and used contact lenses, blister packs, and plastic packaging are accepted.

BRITA® Program

All products and packaging from BRITA® brand products.

Colgate® Oral Care Program

All brands of toothbrushes, toothpaste, packaging, and floss containers.

Personal Care and Beauty Program

All brands of empty personal care and beauty products and packaging.

Batteries

Accepted (11 lbs. or smaller):

- Non-Rechargeable
 - Rechargeable Batteries
- Wet cell batteries are not accepted.

Corks

Corks of all sizes and types are collected. Please make sure corkboards have any glue removed. Plastic corks are not accepted.

Eyeglasses

Eyeglasses, reading glasses, sunglasses, empty frames, and all cases are collected for reuse by charitable organizations.

Gels

The BGA collects used, scraped, and new pre-cut or rolled gel sheets of all types and color. Gel strings are also collected. They can be reused.

Greeting Cards

The BGA collects new and used greeting cards from any occasion.

iPods

All brands of personal music players are collected for the Broadway Alzheimer's iPod Drive. They are donated to local nursing homes.

MetroCards & TransitChek Cards

The BGA collects used or expired MetroCards and TransitChek cards with no value on them.

Program Stuffers

The BGA collects leftover pre-printed and print-as-needed cast change program stuffers. Principal cast members are preferred. They are made into notepads.

Toiletries

The BGA collects new and sealed hotel/motel, travel, and/or sample size toiletries.

Vases

After opening night, we will pick up vases. We can accept vases of any shape and size; please contact us to schedule this pickup.

Textiles and E-Waste

The BGA holds four annual collection drives in the Times Square area for textiles and e-waste.

Textile drives are held in November and May. E-waste drives are held in September and January.

The BGA cannot accept e-waste or textiles in between drives. E-waste can be dropped off at any Staples (the closest may be 776 8th Avenue). Textiles can be dropped off in the AEA Sky Lobby Lounge (165 West 46th St., 4th Floor).

The BGA Binder Project

The BGA Binder Project allows anyone to pick-up, use, and return binders from the program. Binders in good condition are collected. We no longer accept binders larger than 3 inches. Binders with pre-printed covers are also not accepted.
