

The Broadway Green Alliance Internship operates on a single-semester basis for candidates enrolled in College or University to foster academic gain and receive college credit. All operations will be conducted remotely until the BGA resumes in-person duties in their Times Square office. This is a flexible hourly position that reports directly to the Director and Assistant Director.

Interested applicants can expect project- or research-based responsibilities with general support in other areas as needed. This could include helping to create graphic assets, writing pieces for social media or press, or contributing to the development of educational resources. The role is subject to change based on your institution's internship requirements and organizational priorities at the time of the internship.
