



Accessing Parents Web

Parents Web from FACTS is a private and secure parents' portal that will allow parents to view information specific to their children, while protecting their children's information from others.

Here's how to access our easy-to-use **Parents Web**:

- Make sure that the school has **your email address**.
- In Chrome, Firefox or Internet Explorer go to www.factsmgmt.com and click **Parent Login**, then select **FACTS Family Online (Parents Web)**.



- Type the school's District Code: **ICS-THA**. Click **Create New Parents Web Account**.
- Type the User Name: **Your email address** and Click **Create Account** *(you may have to click the Create Account twice)*
