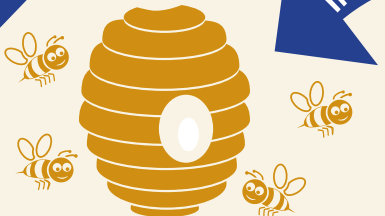

Pipeline

COMPLETED:

- Bridge Cover.* Construction of a bridge cover over the Lake Nina Canal on Old Horatio Avenue is complete.
- Pedestrian and Bicycle Access to the Maitland SunRail Station.* The boardwalk is complete and available for neighbors and station patrons.

IN THE PIPELINE:

- Water Main Extension Project.* One mile of new pipeline will be installed in the northeast part of the City.
