<i>South Australia</i> Fresh and bright on the nose with hints of snowpea and passionfruit. Crisp and lively on the palate with tropical fruit flavours and cleansing acidity.

<i>McLaren Vale</i> Citrus melon and fruit-salad aromas give this Chapel Hill Chardonnay an attractive lifted bouquet and the palate is flavoursome fresh and lively.
