- 1. Pretty Fly for a Black Rye** 16oz Draft **\$5.50**
IPA – Black / 7.9% ABV / 56 IBU
This black IPA has been amped up with a healthy addition of rye. Packed with tropical fruit aroma and flavors. Spicy notes from the rye shine through the roasted and chocolately notes but are not overbearing. Massive amounts of Simcoe, Amarillo, centennial, and Chinook used.
- 2. Western Front** 16oz Draft **\$4.50**
Pilsner – German / 5.3% ABV / 39 IBU
A light-bodied bottom fermented (lager) German beer. Floral hop aroma with a smooth, clean crisp and refreshing flavor. Magnum, tettnang, and hallertau hops used.
- 3. Sugar Hill Blonde** 16oz Draft **\$4.50**
Blonde Ale / 5% ABV / 20 IBU
A classic blonde with German influences. Brewed with German malts and Noble hops.
- 4. Moon Dance** 16oz Draft **\$4.50**
Oatmeal Porter / 5.4% ABV / 28 IBU
Moon Dance is an expression of dark/rich malt flavors. Dark chocolate, rich coffee, and toffee dominate the aroma and flavor. More subtle caramel and dark toast make an appearance as it warms. Flaked oats add a lusciousness of the mouthfeel. Enjoy cold, then let it warm up a little to open up the entire flavor profile.
- 5. Canary in the Coal Mines** 16oz Draft **\$4.50**
Grisette / 4.2% ABV / 26 IBU
Grisette is an almost forgotten farmhouse style which was mostly regarded as a working-class beer of the "miners or factory workers" in Belgium. This historic style is light, crisp, and refreshing. The aroma is almost completely yeast driven and resembles lemon, white pepper, and orange pith. As you move to the flavor, notice the soft notes of cracker and pie crust. Low in bitterness, with a dry finish. Extremely drinkable!
- 6. BoomBox** 16oz Draft **\$5.50**
IPA – American / 8% ABV / 60 IBU
BoomBox is a West Coast Style American IPA. This sub-style of IPA is all about the hops. Aroma resembles grapefruit, pine, lemongrass, and papaya. The flavor displays very subtle malt, acting as a canvas for the more promenade hop flavors, which echo the aroma. Enjoy cold, or let it warm a bit for a more complex profile.
- 7. Double Trouble** 16oz Draft **\$5.50**
IPA – Double / 9% ABV / 85 IBU
An IPA loaded with tropical fruits. Citrus notes such as grapefruit, oranges, and lemons. Slightly earthy and pine characters compliment the citrus notes. These flavors are from a combination of Summit, Cascade, Armamarillo, Citra, and Simcoe hops.
- 8. White Noise** 16oz Draft **\$4.50**
Witbier / 4.8% ABV / 18 IBU
The aroma will greet you with light malty sweetness, accompanied by fresh coriander and orange zest. Very refreshing balanced flavor. This historic style focuses on the flavor contributions from a medley of brewer's malt and traditional yeast. Complex. Approachable. Elegant.
- 9. Warm and Fuzzy** 16oz Draft **\$5.50**
Scotch Ale / 9% ABV / 20 IBU
This strong Scottish ale offers a deep, rich flavor with notes of dark caramel, biscuit, and a subtle roasted nuts. A heavier body and higher alcohol content makes this the perfect choice for a cold night. This beer reminds us of a warm, comfortable, blanket.
- 10. OverMountain Brown** 16oz Draft **\$4.50**
American Brown Ale / 6.8% ABV / 30 IBU
OverMountain Brown is a collaboration with our local homebrew club (OverMountain Brewers of Abingdon, VA). Easy drinking with a beautiful light brown color. A prominent undercurrent of spicy, earthy, and citrus character from the hops is found in the aroma. A swallow of this beer has a richness from toasted malts. These have a wonderful nutty chocolate flavor which fades into a comforting toffee smoothness.
