2. Approve the agenda, but move the Executive session to be first, Councilman Carter moved to approve moving the executive session first and going into executive session to discuss real estate, Councilwoman Wall second, all approved. 6:05 p.m.
3. Councilman Carter moved to come out of Executive Session, Councilman Gates seconded, all approved, 6:10 p.m.
4. Councilman Carter moved to set the minimum bid on the building located on Jones Mill Rd to \$128,000.00, Councilwoman Wall second, all approved.
5. Approved the March 5, 2018 minutes, Councilman Carter moved to approve minutes, Councilman Gates second, all approved.

10. Projects
 - a. City Hall project is on schedule and on budget, the finishing date is still April 15, 2018, they are still working the holding cell, finishing the painting, floors, carpet and reception area. Crown Industries will be providing the Handicap Parking decals at no charge.
 - b. Cell Tower is almost complete that is located on Cove Rd.
11. County/State Initiatives
 - a. Lake Meriwether update; working on the trails, updating the bathrooms, lights at the RV Park and a dock at the lake, Councilman Carter advised he is trying to get playground equipment at the lake also.
 - b. Comprehensive Plan next meeting will be March 29, 2018 at 6:00 p.m. at city hall, two representatives from Three Rivers met with Mayor Ledbetter and

Councilwoman Ledbetter to look over the present zoning map, GIS map and discussed future plans for Woodbury.

- c. DOT had met with Mayor Ledbetter and presented several plans for Main Street parking; leaving it the same, parallel parking on either sides or just one side will be parallel parking, the street size will be reduced from 16' to 12' roadway. If parallel parking is chosen, DOT will install two crosswalks one at the new city hall location and one at the tennis courts. Councilman Carter moved to approve the 3rd plan for parking on Main Street, Councilwoman Wall second, all approved.
- d. Open Air Meriwether, artist from surrounding areas come and paint pictures of Meriwether County. These paintings will be on exhibit and for sale at the Square Gallery in Greenville.

- b. Jimmy Sibley spoke to the council about the update Visitor guide and requested that the city purchase an ad.


