
The first order of business for the DDA was to discuss progress on the 1911 Building. Mr. Lee Handcock of Thompson Gas is ready to go on the contracts, and Mr. Ron Hall has completed the inspection and been paid a total of \$875.00 for this job. We are asking United Bank to extend for thirty days the closing on this loan to allow all the inspections to take place. The group voted to agree to this idea.

Scott Callaway of Phoenix Mobility wants to rent the old doctor's building on Jones Mill Road. WDA decided to agree to the rental of this building for \$1,000 a month for one year.

Mayor Ledbetter asked the members to look up Meriwether County's comprehensive plan online paying special attention to the nine pages of the material that concerns Woodbury.

On the IDA side of the meeting, the group was advised that the Marvin Williams building in the park had been sold.

Before adjourning the meeting, Kera talked about trying to encourage our business owners in town by having a business forum in April where all the owners would be invited to come together to discuss their issues and offer suggestions on what the city and the development authority could do to help encourage their growth and success. The group agreed that this is a good idea, and we would help facilitate this event.
