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Gedney Cemetery, Mamaroneck, New York

Introduction:

One of the most visible, and oldest, family plots in the county lies near an entrance ramp to I-95 North on Mamaroneck Avenue in Mamaroneck. A metal arch, its green paint flaking, reads "Gedney Cemetery," a stone wall encircling a grove of trees and a plot of land whose graves date to 1722.

It's the Eleazar Gedney Burial Ground, its stones and obelisks a veritable museum of changing memorials, from the curve-topped red sandstone slabs typical of the 1700s to the flat polished granite of the 20th century. Step into it, cushioned with moss and fallen acorns, and the world disappears.

Eleazar [though spelled Eleazor] Gedney Burial Ground was established on the outskirts of Mamaroneck, NY when Eleazar Gedney (b. March 18, 1665) of Rye, NY died on October 27, 1722. His grave next to that of his wife – Mary Ann Mott Gedney (1670-1750) known as “Anna, his wife” is marked by two rocks since the original tombstone no longer exists. It is one of the oldest cemeteries in Westchester County, NY with multiple 18th century tombstones – many of which still have legible inscriptions.

Located at Latitude 40.9539 N and Longitude –73.7269 W, Gedney Cemetery holds roughly 200 graves. They consist primarily of members of the Gedney, Carpenter, Dixon, Hadden, Lawrence, Secor and Taylor families. It is also the likely resting place for several African-American slaves based on stone markers (the customary practice to mark the graves of indentured servants during the 18th and early 19th centuries in many areas) and the fact that early records as stated on the [Slavery in Mamaroneck Township](#) website indicate that ancestors and relatives of the interred (e.g. Absolom Gidney held 4 slaves as of the 1790 census; Isaac Gidney held one slave as of the 1790 census; while members

of the Gray, Hadden, Merritt, and Mott families based on 1790, 1800, and 1810 census information also held slaves since slavery dated as far back as 1698 in the Rye/Mamaroneck area.

Gedney Cemetery, populated by many trees, consists of a stone wall, rusted gate and arch that reads “Gedney Cemetery,” and two entrances on its west side. It is bounded by a river on its north and east sides. Mamaroneck Avenue, a heavily traveled four-lane road is located directly west of the cemetery. The New England Thruway (I-95) is located to the north and the east of Gedney Burial Ground. An entrance and exit ramp from I-95 north is located directly south of the burial ground.

Wildlife consists of various types of birds (e.g. blue jays, sparrows), insects, squirrels (black and gray), and even occasionally deer. Flora consists of oak trees, wild flowers, and lichens, to name a few.

Though no longer in use, Gedney Burial Ground was an active cemetery for 220 years from 1722 to 1942.

Gedney Facts:

John Gedney, the patriarch of the Gedney family was among the original settlers at Salem, Massachusetts when he arrived on the Mary Anne in 1636.

Members of the Gedney family led by Eleazar Gedney, who is buried at Gedney Cemetery in Mamaroneck, NY settled in Westchester County (Mamaroneck, Rye, and White Plains) in the early 18th century.

The American Revolution was particularly difficult on the Gedneys since some remained loyal to the British crown. Thomas Fairfax, 6th Lord of Fairfax of Cameron (the great-grandson of Bartholomew Gedney (the brother of Eleazar) who had served as one of the judges during the Salem Witch Trials during the 1690s) lost all of his landholdings which comprise Fairfax, Virginia; Joshua Gedney lost his land holdings in Dutchess County, which eventually became the property of the Vanderbilts and President Franklin D. Roosevelt; and both Joshua and his brother, Joseph, were forced to change their name to "Gidney" and flee to New Brunswick and Nova Scotia, respectively, in 1783.

Absolom and Isaac Gedney of Mamaroneck, NY were also forced to change their name to "Gidney" although they fared better. Isaac, though initially arrested for his criticism of the Provisional Congress and Cannon Spiking Incident in 1776 was released out of sympathy because of his large number of dependent children.

Eleazar Gedney and his family relocated from Salem, Massachusetts to areas comprising Rye and Mamaroneck, NY prior to 1692 purchasing a sizeable tract of land from

Caleb Heathecote. His sons, John and James were born to Mary Anne Mott "Anna" (his wife) in Mamaroneck, NY in ca. 1692/1693 and ca. 1695/1696, respectively. The four are buried at Gedney Cemetery.

Before long, the Gedneys established roots elsewhere in Westchester County (notably White Plains) as well as in Ulster, Sullivan, and Rockland Counties, becoming one of the largest landholders of the time in Westchester County.

James (1699-1766) later married Phebe Horton (1705-1799) (also buried at Gedney Cemetery) creating the Gedney-Horton line to which most of the Gedneys (many with blue eyes and light hair) in Mamaroneck, White Plains, and Gedney Cemetery belong.

Aside from John and James, Eleazar Gedney and his wife had five other children, who married into the Horton, Carpenter, Fowler, Haines and Secor Families.

- ❖ Caleb Gedney (1823-1854) has two tombstones located in different areas of the cemetery.
- ❖ Silvanus Gedney (1801-1889) married three times – Nancy M. (1795-1842), Susan M. (1812-1857), and Margaret (1829-1862).
- ❖ Eleazar Gedney (1665-1722) was the first person buried at Gedney Cemetery.
- ❖ Genevra Lawrence (1865-1942) was the last person buried at Gedney Cemetery.
- ❖ Mahala Lawrence (1836-1934) was the oldest person buried at Gedney Cemetery when she died at the age of 97.

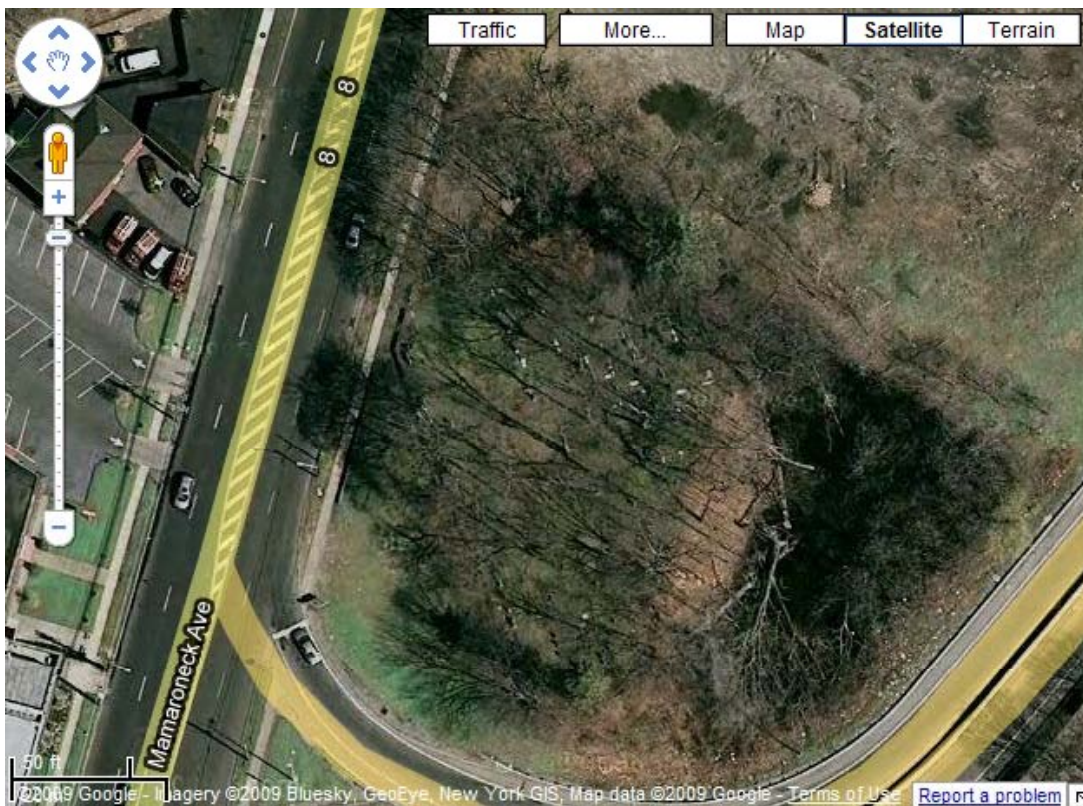
Eleazar Gedney's held several political positions in the town government of Mamaroneck during his lifetime. They were:

- ❖ Fence Viewer (chosen April 4, 1699)
- ❖ Recorder (elected April 2, 1708)
- ❖ Sessar (April 25, 1710)

Eleazar Gedney's original tombstone read: "1722. Here lies Eleazar Gedney deceased Oct. 27. Born in the Boston Government."

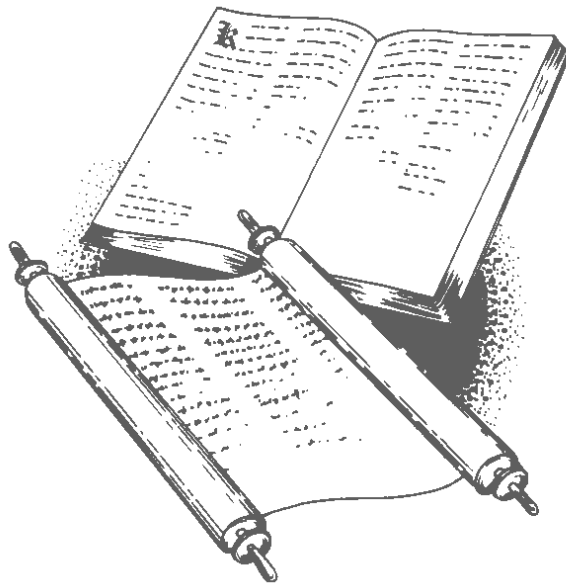

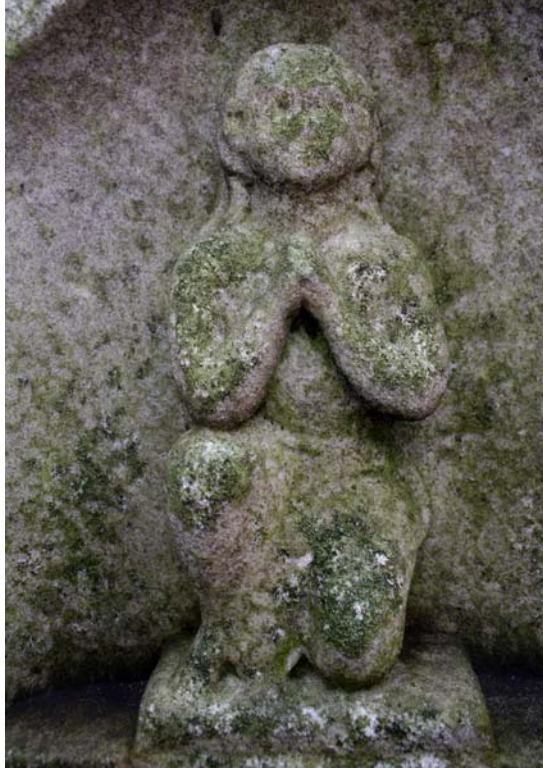

Gedney Cemetery Symbols:

18th Century:



Bones

- ❖ Bones symbolize human mortality and death.



Bones & Serpent Swallowing Its Tail

- ❖ Bones symbolize human mortality and death.
- ❖ Serpent swallowing its tail represents eternity.

19th Century:



Angel Carrying The Departed Soul as a Child

- ❖ Symbolizes a messenger of God carrying, escorting, or guiding the deceased to Heaven.



Badge

- ❖ Symbolizes the deceased led an honorable and righteous life worthy of eternal life.
- ❖ Blank slate symbolizes virtue.
- ❖ Also symbolizes courage and fortitude.



Hand

- ❖ Symbol of life.
- ❖ Depict deceased's relationships with God and other human beings.
- ❖ Pointing upwards symbolizes the reward of eternal life received for righteousness and the deceased's ascension to Heaven.



Holly

- ❖ Symbolize Foresight



Inverted Torch

- ❖ Symbolizes death
- ❖ Flame represents eternal life.



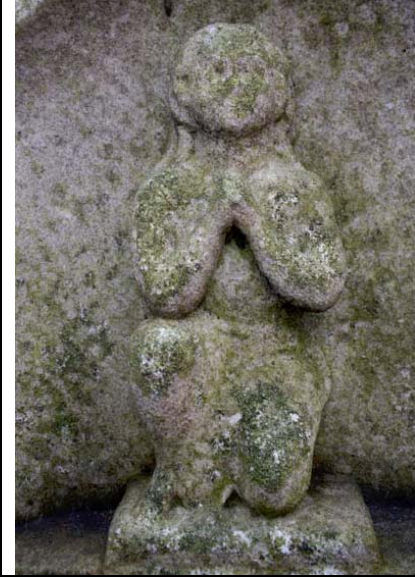
Lamb

- ❖ Common 19th century symbol found on a child's grave. Symbol of Christ: "Behold the Lamb of God, which taketh away the sin of the world" [John 1:29].
- ❖ Personifies innocence, meekness, gentleness and humility.



Oak Leaves

- ❖ Symbolize Indestructibility of the soul – "As mighty as an oak!"
- ❖ Also depicts strength, power, honor, endurance, eternity.
- ❖ Tree of life during pre-Christianity and believed to be the tree from which the wood of Christ's cross was made.



Praying Child

- ❖ Symbolizes the untimely death of the innocent (usually a young child).
- ❖ Represent purity and innocence.
- ❖ Prayer symbolizes the existence of God and eternal life.



Urn

- ❖ Greek symbol of mourning.
- ❖ Reminder that the body is a vessel of the soul.
- ❖ Also represents an ossuary for bones.



Vessel with Flame

- ❖ Symbolizes the eternal flame and eternal nature of the soul.

20th Century:



Crown

- ❖ Symbolizes immortality, victory, righteousness, triumph, and the resurrection.
- ❖ Symbolic of honor and glory.

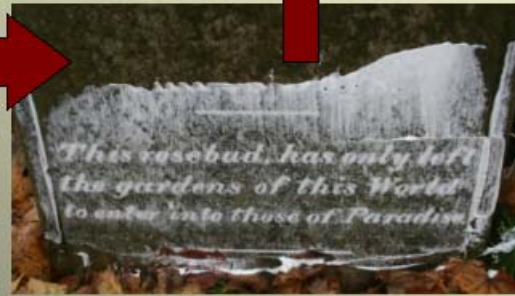

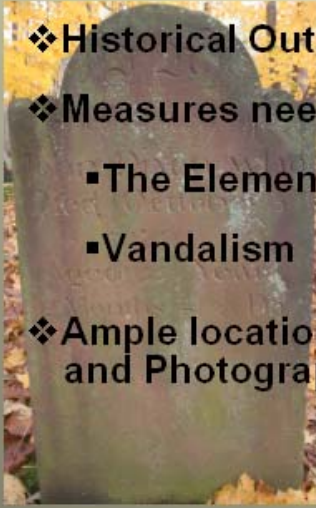
