



THE HEARTS WE SOUD

Emily Lloyd-Jones's

SMALL KNITTED HEART



Yarn

1 ball of chunky yarn

NEEDLES

6 - 8m circular or straight needles 1 tapestry needle

ABBREVIATIONS

BO bind off

CO cast on

K, k knit

k2tog knit two sts together

M1 make one stitch

st(s) stitch(es)

DIRECTIONS

Notes: Emily's Small Knitted Heart has all rows knitted in garter stich.

Long Tail CO 3sts.

Row 1: K3 (3sts total). Turn.

Row 2: K1, M1, K2 sts. (4sts total). Turn.

Row 3: K4 sts. Turn.

Row 4: K1, M1, K3 sts (5sts total). Turn.

Row 5: K5 sts. Turn.

Row 6: K5 sts. Turn. Cut yarn.

Slide all sitches to the bottom of the needle.

On the same needle: Long Tail WCO 3sts

Row 7: K1 (3sts total). Turn.

Row 8: K1, M1, K2 (4sts total). Turn.

Row 9: K4 sts. Turn.

Row 10: K1, M1, K3 sts. (5sts total). Turn.

Row 11: K5 sts. Turn.

Row 12: K5 sts. Turn.

Don't break yarn the second time.

This creates the top of the heart. You should now have both tops of the heart on one needle. Make sure the bumpy (purl sts) side is facing up.

Row 13: K10 (Knit 10 sts across to join the 2

"humps" together)

Row 14: K4, K2tog, K4 (9sts total). Turn.

Row 15: K9 sts. Turn.

Row 16: K4, K2tog, K3 (8sts total). Turn.

Row 17: K8 sts. Turn.

Row 18: K3, K2tog, K3 (7sts total) Turn.

Row 19: K7 sts. Turn.

Row 20: K3, K2tog, K2 (6sts total) Turn.

Row 21: K6 sts. Turn.

Row 22: K2, K2tog, K2 (5sts total) Turn.

Row 23: K5 sts. Turn.

Row 24: K2, K2tog, K1 (4sts total) Turn.

Row 25: K4 sts. Turn.

Row 26: K2, K2tog, K1 (4sts total) Turn.

Row 27: K4 sts. Turn.

Row 28: K1, K2tog, K1 (3sts total) Turn.

Row 29: K3 sts. Turn.

Row 30: K1, K2tog (2sts total) Turn.

Row 31: BO, weave in ends and the other loose yarn ends into the edges of the heart with tapestry
