• What is the UN MGCY?

The UN MGCY is the formal engagement mechanism for young people at the UN. It is mandated by the United Nations General Assembly to be self organised and engage in numerous policy processes related to sustainable development.

• What does the UN MGCY do?

Its primary purpose is engaging communities of young people in the Design, Implementation, Monitoring, and Follow Up & Review of sustainable development policies at all levels.

• How does UN MGCY Receive its Mandate?

Agenda 21 (1992); several UN General Assembly Resolutions (such as 2013's A/Res/67/290); Agreements with UN bodies and conferences

Platform that encourages young people to lead, join, showcase, and share innovative and effective actions aimed at addressing the needs of people and planet.

Knowledge

Platform for dialogue to create an evidence base for best practices through the assessment of existing knowledge, generating new knowledge, identification of emerging issues, and effective use and dissemination.



Membership

Membership in UN MGCY is facilitated through an open process. Any formal and informal child-led, youth-led and child-and-youth-serving entities, as well as their members and individuals, may join. All members and focal points engage on a voluntary basis.

Universal model of membership, promoting a system where "no one is left behind".

All members of the UN MGCY must, first and foremost:

- agree to adhere to the Process and Procedures of the UN MGCY;
- agree with the principles of the UN Charter;
- agree with the values and principles of the UN MGCY as expressed in its vision
 "the collective principles of solidarity, justice, equity, universality, inclusion, human rights and the integrity of the planet".

The membership is divided between the following categories:

- Any youth-led or child-led entity that is representative of the interests of children and/or youth,
- Any individual not part of one of the above mentioned categories, may join the UN MGCY through becoming a member UNMGCY's legal entity called Children Youth International (CYI).
