Application Guidelines

Applications are open for post-docs and advanced PhD students who are enrolled in a cancer immunotherapy program.

Interested young scientists must submit a scientific abstract, a scientific CV, and a letter of intent which describes their academic and professional goals and projects. As there are only 24 spots available, applications are evaluated and selected by the Summer School program committee.

Abstract Format

- Please submit text to office@cimt.eu as a Word document only.
- The abstract text should not exceed a maximum of 3,000 characters (incl. spaces). Double-check all your special characters.
- Titles should be indicative of the content of the abstract. All words necessary to identify
 the subject matter should be included in the title. Avoid non-standard abbreviations in
 abstract titles.
- Abstracts must describe in a succinct manner the purposes and results of the research
 so that the quality, novelty, and comprehensiveness of the work can be evaluated by the
 Scientific Abstract Committee. Each abstract should contain: (a) an introductory
 sentence indicating the purposes of the study; (b) a brief description of pertinent
 experimental procedures; (c) a summary of the data; and (d) a statement of the
 conclusions. These should be provided as a single paragraph without any subheading.
- Consistent American or British spelling should be used throughout.

- Abbreviations may be used in the body of an abstract if they are defined at their first mention in the text. Complex therapeutic regimens must be identified.
- No citation, figure, table, or any type of illustration should be added to the abstract.

The CV and letter of intent should be submitted as a PDF. Please send all required documents to office@cimt.eu by May 27, 2022. Notifications will be sent at the end of June 2022.

Every accepted participant will have the opportunity to present their research with a poster and a short talk.

At the Summer School venue, you will be provided with a 1m (width) x 1.5m (height) space to display your poster.

Registration Fee

The registration fee of 350 EUR will only be due upon your acceptance of our participation notification. The fee covers accommodation in shared rooms, all meals, and transfer from Verona. Single-occupancy rooms are available for an additional fee.
