The Emerging Leaders Plenary Session

SESSION OVERVIEW

We have witnessed an increased priority placement on sustainability and climate efforts at the federal, state, and local levels. To ensure a future where the best and brightest minds are leading discussion tables, advocating for policy reform, while centering equity, it is imperative that the current practitioners invest in the next generation thought leaders. We believe this "Emerging Leaders" plenary session is one example of actualizing such an investment.

High school students (intergenerational thought leaders) from across the region will convene to discuss and develop scalable sustainability strategies influenced by local challenges. Through information sharing, storytelling, and leveraging lived and learned experiences we are hopeful to create an empirical ethos that fosters the adoption of effective strategies. Engaging honestly through active listening will reduce the learning curve, allowing the development of new approaches that represent the convergence of diversity of thought for local and regional goals alike.

During this session intergenerational thought leaders will provide an overview of our System of Sustainability, and reframe the System of Sustainability objectives to align with an intergenerational focus. They will discuss interdependence for collaboration and network development as well as how to transition from theoretical learning to practical application that creates collective impact and social mobilization. Additionally, we want to ensure that <u>equity</u> is centered in all the work. Lastly, there will be a focused discussion on a collective call to action.
