Recap of Fall 2016 Events

The Memphis Symphony Orchestra welcomed a new principal conductor, Robert Moody, as the 2016-2017 performance season began. The Memphis Symphony Chorus was pleased to perform under Moody's direction in Fall 2016. Fall concerts included works by Forrest (*In Paradisium*) and Vaughn Williams (*Dona Nobis Pacem*) performed November 12 and 13, and the Magic of Memphis Holiday Spectacular concert December 2 and 4, complete with acrobats from Cirque de la Symphonie.

On November 10th before heading to the Cannon Center for rehearsal, the MSC pulled off a flash mob performance in the produce section of the new Midtown Kroger on Union. With Robert Moody singing the lead vocal, MSO's Scott Moore on his trumpet, and Dr. Larry Edwards directing us, we sang Leonard Cohens' *Halleluiah*.
