My New Friend Is So Fun! - Reading Guide

Author/Illustrator: Mo Willems Themes: friendship, new/old friends

Lesson/Notes: Gerald and Snake are upset about their best friends having new friends but come to realize they are not being replaced. If your friend spends time with another friend, it doesn't mean (s)he is not your friend anymore. It's okay to have more than one friend.

Discussion Questions

- Why were Gerald and Snake worried about Piggie and Brian spending time together?
 (thought they would lose their best friends)
- Is it okay to have more than one friend? (yes)
- What do you think Gerald and/or Snake were thinking at the end of the story? Did they seem worried still?

Activity: Mini Friends

Supplies: PlayDoh

- Use one container of PlayDoh to make as many animal friends as possible. Encourage child to make a variety of animals.
- Remind child that it is okay for his/her friends to have other friends. Invite child to act out a story with playdoh friends.
