**Mark 16:17-18 NKJV** <sup>17</sup> And these signs will follow those who believe: In My name they will cast out demons; they will speak with new tongues; <sup>18</sup> they will take up serpents; and if they drink anything deadly, it will by no means hurt them; they will lay hands on the sick, and they will recover.”

**1 Corinthians 12:7-11 NKJV** <sup>7</sup> But the manifestation of the Spirit is given to each one for the profit of all: <sup>8</sup> for to one is given the word of wisdom through the Spirit, to another the word of knowledge through the same Spirit, <sup>9</sup> to another faith by the same Spirit, to another gifts of healings by the same Spirit, <sup>10</sup> to another the working of miracles, to another prophecy, to another discerning of spirits, to another different kinds of tongues, to another the interpretation of tongues. <sup>11</sup> But one and the same Spirit works all these things, distributing to each one individually as He wills.

**1 Corinthians 14:20; 22-25 NKJV** <sup>20</sup> Brethren, do not be children in understanding; however, in malice be babes, but in understanding be mature. <sup>22</sup> Therefore tongues are for a sign, not to those who believe but to unbelievers; but prophesying is not for unbelievers but for those who believe. <sup>23</sup> Therefore if the whole church comes together in one place, and all speak with tongues, and there come in those who are uninformed or unbelievers, will they not say that you are out of your mind? <sup>24</sup> But if all prophesy, and an unbeliever or an uninformed person comes in, he is convinced by all, he is convicted by all. <sup>25</sup> [b]And thus the secrets of his heart are revealed; and so, falling down on his face, he will worship God and report that God is truly among you.

**1 Corinthians 13:8-10 NKJV** <sup>8</sup> Love never fails. But whether there are prophecies, they will fail; whether there are tongues, they will cease; whether there is knowledge, it will vanish away. <sup>9</sup> For we know in part and we prophesy in part. <sup>10</sup> But when that which is perfect has come, then that which is in part will be done away.

**1 Corinthians 13:11-12 NKJV** <sup>11</sup> When I was a child, I spoke as a child, I understood as a child, I thought as a child; but when I became a man, I put away childish things. <sup>12</sup> For now we see in a mirror, dimly, but then face to face. Now I know in part, but then I shall know just as I also am known.

**1 Corinthians 14:18, 23 NKJV** <sup>18</sup> I thank my God I speak with tongues more than you all; <sup>19</sup> yet in the church I would rather speak five words with my understanding, that I may teach others also, than ten thousand words in a tongue.<sup>23</sup> Therefore if the whole church comes together in one place, and all speak with tongues, and there come in those who are uninformed or unbelievers, will they not say that you are <sup>Ⓜ</sup>out of your mind?

**Genesis 11:5-8 NLT** <sup>5</sup> But the Lord came down to look at the city and the tower the people were building.<sup>6</sup> “Look!” he said. “The people are united, and they all speak the same language. After this, nothing they set out to do will be impossible for them! <sup>7</sup> Come, let’s go down and confuse the people with different languages. Then they won’t be able to understand each other.” <sup>8</sup> In that way, the Lord scattered them all over the world, and they stopped building the city.

**1 Corinthians 12:11 NKJV** <sup>11</sup> But one and the same Spirit works all these things, distributing to each one individually as He wills.

**1 Corinthians 12:29-30 NKJV** <sup>29</sup> Are all apostles? Are all prophets? Are all teachers? Are all workers of miracles? <sup>30</sup> Do all have gifts of healings? Do all speak with tongues? Do all interpret?

**1 Corinthians 13:1 NKJV** <sup>1</sup> Though I speak with the tongues of men and of angels, but have not love, I have become sounding brass or a clanging cymbal.

**1 Corinthians 13:13 NKJV** <sup>13</sup> And now abide faith, hope, love, these three; but the greatest of these is love.

**1 Corinthians 14:1 NKJV** <sup>1</sup> Pursue love, and desire spiritual gifts, but especially that you may prophesy.
