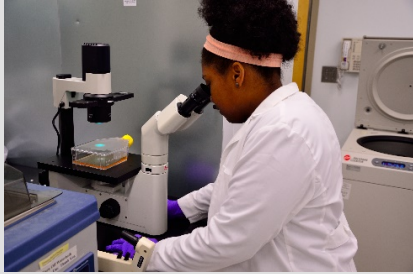
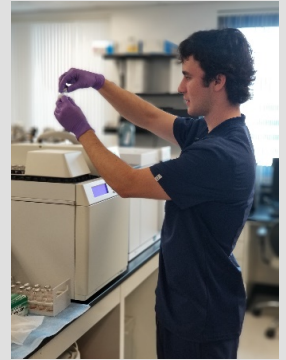


# Center for Precision Medicine Undergraduate Summer Research Internship
