As a Canadian national women-centric organization, we are committed to upholding

the Canadian Charter of Rights and Freedoms and recognize it to be the foundation that protects us as women, a religious minority, and racialized minorities. The Charter also sets out equality rights. Everyone in Canada has the right to the equal protection and benefit of the law, without discrimination. This means that the laws in Canada must be applied equally to all people, without regard to personal characteristics such as race, national or ethnic origin, sex, age, or disability (among others). We seize this opportunity to create a better future for all Muslim women and girls!

In Iran, Afghanistan, India, China and other parts of the world, Muslim women are at the centre of misogyny and disempowerment by despotic and cruel regimes and their supporters.

CCMW continues to fight for our rights here and abroad and our resolve will not be shaken. This is a fight that we must fight together!
