

A Dedicated House

2 Chronicles 5

- 1 Kings 8 and 2 Chronicles 5-7 record the account of the dedication of the Temple.
- It is the most detailed account of a dedication service in the Bible.
- Solomon's prayer in the dedication is the longest recorded prayer in the Bible.

What Solomon's Temple was to be about is what we must be about as the temple of God:

A House of Dedicated Worship to God.

silver: a type of redemption (represents what God has done for His people).

gold: a type of royalty and Deity (represents who God is).

Instruments: a type of vessels (for God to use).

The Focus of Worship (2 Chronicles 5:2)

- The ark of the covenant represented the throne and presence of God in the Temple.
- The ark of the covenant was a type of Christ:
 - -The mercy seat pictures atonement (Christ is our mercy seat).
 - -It was made of wood (pictured the humanity of Christ).
 - -It was overlaid with pure gold within and without (pictured the Deity of Christ.
- As the ark of the covenant pictured Christ in the Temple that Solomon built, Christ is in us, the temple of God:

"And if Christ be in you..." (Romans 8:10)

[&]quot;...but Christ liveth in me..." (Galatians 2:20)

[&]quot;That Christ may dwell in your hearts by faith..." (Ephesians 3:17)

[&]quot;...which is Christ in you, the hope of glory:" (Colossians 1:27)

The Focus of Worship is bringing Glory to God through the
Any worship offered to God today that is not offered through, is false worship. It is impossible to worship God apart from truth (John 4:24). Jesus is the truth and the only way to God (John 14:6). Without Jesus, we can do nothing; including worship God (John 15:5). Glory is rendered to God through much fruit as disciples of Jesus Christ (John 15:8).
Critical: To bring glory to God through His Son, means that we must with His Son.
Someone can be saved but not have a relationship with Christ. Someone can know the word of God very well but not in it (John 15:7).
Critical: It is impossible to be a dedicated house of worship to God without a deep love for His
