2 Chronicles 5

- The dedication of the Temple took place 11 months after it was completed (1 Kings 6:38).
- Solomon dedicated the Temple during the Feast of Tabernacles.

The Preparation for Worship (2 Chronicles 5:3)

Preparation is essential for _____.

Matthew 15:8

- The number "7" represents perfection.
 - It took seven years for the Temple to be built (1 Kings 6:38).
 - The Feast of Tabernacles was observed in the seventh month (2 Chronicles 5:3).
 - The Feast of Tabernacles was the seventh and final feast that was to be observed (Leviticus 23).
 - The Jews were to dwell in booths for seven days during the Feast of Tabernacles (Leviticus 23:42).
 - The Second Coming of Christ will end Daniel's seventieth week and begin the Millennial reign of Christ (the Feast of Tabernacles will be reinstated - Zechariah 14:16-19).

Zechariah 14:16-19

- God took worship seriously in the Old Testament, He will take it seriously during the Millennial reign of Christ, and He takes it as seriously in the church age.
