•	The number "7" represents perfection. -It took seven years for the Temple to be built (1 Kings 6:38). -The Feast of Tabernacles was observed in the seventh month (2 Chronicles 5:3). -The Feast of Tabernacles was the seventh and final feast that was to be observed (Leviticus 23). -The Jews were to dwell in booths for seven days during the Feast of Tabernacles (Leviticus 23:42). - The Second Coming of Christ will end Daniel's seventieth week and begin the Millennial reign of Christ (the Feast of Tabernacles will be reinstated - Zechariah 14:16-19).
