MAIN POINTS

- The question is, do you still have the zeal today, that you started with in your ministry?
- 2 The mere thought of strong ministry opposition will either cause you to run from danger or run into it.
- The way to finish strong is to begin with a confident attitude, that God is greater than any opposition especially when we hold onto His promises.
- A church without viable discipleship and mission ministries will wander in the worldly desert and produce no fruit.
- When you make ministry about your personal relationship with the Lord, it does not matter what negativity others bring.
- Refocusing your position might mean repositioning your position
- 7 If you want to finish strong, then you must be willing to say "Give me this mountain"
- Sustaining Faith is asking for that mountain, a willingness to climb it and claim it for the Lord.
