New Pension Relief Legislation Moving Through Congress This Week

Butch Lewis Emergency Pension Plan Relief Act of 2021

This week, we expect new legislation, the Butch Lewis Emergency Pension Plan Relief Act of 2021, to start working through Congressional committees. This legislation would address the solvency issues facing Central States, while avoiding benefit reductions to our participants.

If this bill successfully passes out of the House Ways and Means and Budget committees, it can be included in the upcoming COVID-19 relief bill that will be considered in the House and Senate. We are encouraged that Members of Congress are considering this desperately needed solution to nationwide multiemployer pension crisis.
