

Parent Checklist

Start the conversation. Now is the time to let your student know that their dreams can
absolutely become a possibility. Planning and working hard now is the key.
Explore conversations that tie their extracurricular activities to a career path.
Help your student set specific goals for each school year and encourage study habits
that complement your child's goals. Set aside time to review your student's work when
possible.
