# 1. What does glorification/glorious mean?

- Glorification/Glorious  $\delta \delta \xi \alpha$  (doxa),  $\eta \varsigma$  ( $\bar{e}s$ ),  $\dot{\eta}$  ( $h\bar{e}$ ): n.fem.;
- The word *doxa* is used in many ways in the NT. It is most relevant to aesthetic beauty when it is used in connection with the ideas of brightness and majesty. *Doxa* is often characterized by or used in conjunction with brilliant light.

- Philippians 3:20–21 <sup>20</sup> For our conversation is in heaven; from whence also we look for the Saviour, the Lord Jesus Christ: <sup>21</sup> Who shall change <u>our vile body</u>, that it may be <u>fashioned</u> like unto his <u>glorious body</u>, according to the working whereby he is able even to subdue all things unto himself.
- Psalm 90:17 And let the <u>beauty of the LORD our God</u> be <u>upon</u> us...

# 4. When do we receive this glorious body?

• 1 Thessalonians 4:13–18 - <sup>13</sup> But I would not have you to be ignorant, brethren, concerning them which are asleep, that ye sorrow not, even as others which have no hope. <sup>14</sup> For if we believe that Jesus died and rose again, even so them also which sleep in Jesus will God bring with him. <sup>15</sup> For this we say unto you by the word of the Lord, that we which are alive *and* remain unto the coming of the Lord shall not prevent them which are asleep. <sup>16</sup> For the Lord himself shall descend from heaven with a shout, with the voice of the archangel, and with the trump of God: and the dead in Christ shall rise first: <sup>17</sup> Then we which are alive *and* remain shall be caught up together with them in the clouds, to meet the Lord in the air: and so shall we ever be with the Lord. <sup>18</sup> Wherefore comfort one another with these words.

# 5. How do we receive this glorious body?

• 2 Corinthians 4:4 - In whom the god of this world hath blinded the minds of them which believe not, lest the <u>light</u> of the <u>glorious</u> gospel of <u>Christ</u>, who is the <u>image of God</u>, should shine unto them.





- Example of these end time people: Moses
- 2 Corinthians 3:7–8 7 But if the ministration of death, written and engraven in stones, was glorious, so that the children of Israel could not stedfastly behold the face of Moses for the glory of his countenance; which glory was to be done away: 8 How shall not the ministration of the spirit be rather glorious?

# 6. Those who desire a glorified body must first be sealed:

- Revelation 7:1–4 ¹ And after these things I saw four angels standing on the four corners of the earth, holding the four winds of the earth, that the wind should not blow on the earth, nor on the sea, nor on any tree. ² And I saw another angel ascending from the east, having the seal of the living God: and he cried with a loud voice to the four angels, to whom it was given to hurt the earth and the sea, ³ Saying, Hurt not the earth, neither the sea, nor the trees, till we have sealed the servants of our God in their foreheads. ⁴ And I heard the number of them which were sealed: and there were sealed an hundred and forty and four thousand of all the tribes of the children of Israel.
- Revelation 14:1–5 ¹ And I looked, and, lo, a Lamb stood on the mount Sion, and with him an hundred forty and four thousand, having his Father's name written in their foreheads. ² And I heard a voice from heaven, as the voice of many waters, and as the voice of a great thunder: and I heard the voice of harpers harping with their harps: ³ And they sung as it were a new song before the throne, and before the four beasts, and the elders: and no man could learn that song but the hundred and forty and four thousand, which were redeemed from the earth. ⁴ These are they which were not defiled with women; for they are virgins. These are they which follow the Lamb whithersoever he goeth. These





were redeemed from among men, *being* the firstfruits unto God and to the Lamb. <sup>5</sup> And in their mouth was found no guile: for they are without fault before the throne of God.

• **Revelation 22:4** - And they shall see his face; and his name *shall* be in their foreheads.
