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# How To Set Up Your Dating Profile

Your dating profile is the first thing your potential matches will see.

Share important and interesting things about yourself to attract compatible people. Here's a guide for creating an attractive and authentic dating profile!



#### **Pictures**

Your first photo is the first thing other people will see. Choose one that makes you feel attractive and confident!

Include more than one photo to let other people know you're a real person.

### **Description**



Talk about your hobbies and interests! You want to give people looking at your profile a sense of who you are.

Consider including what you are looking for in a relationship. For example, "Looking for something casual" or "Looking for a serious relationship."



#### **BE YOURSELF**

You want people to swipe right because they're interested in **you!** 

# Dating Profile Do's and Don'ts

#### **DO Pick a Current Photo**

Use photos from the past 1-2 years.

#### **DON'T Use Group Photos**

It may be hard to figure out which one is you.

#### **DO Share Your Values**

Talk about things that are important to you. You're more likely to attract compatible people!

#### **DON'T Be Close-Minded**

It's good to know what you want, but don't be too specific.

People can surprise you!

Tips

Keep messages brief.

Ask questions! People love to talk about themselves.

Speak to things you have in common.

Type a keyword or emotion to find the matching emoji!

Give yourself time to grieve.

Move on to finding more authentic connections.

# **Dealing with Rejection**

Not every relationship will have a happy ending. Some people will not return your feelings, or they may want to end the relationship.

Rejection is a natural part of life, and can be hurtful.

Just remember that each rejection is an opportunity to move on and find the right person!

#### What Do I Do?

Send a **brief message** asking for honesty and clarification.

"I haven't heard from you in a while. I'd like to talk more, otherwise I wish you the best."

If they continue to ignore you, it's best to end communication.



# Sexting

When being with your partner in-person is not an option, sexting is an alternative

### What is Sexting?

Sexting is the sending or receiving of sexual content using technology like your phone, a dating app, or webcam. Sexting can be:

- · Nude or semi-nude pictures or video
- Messages describing sex acts
- Pictures or videos of sex acts
- Live chats on webcams involving sex acts

Sexting can be a great way to explore your sexuality, trust, boundaries, and intimacy.

The choice to engage in sexting is a personal one, and comes with some risk. It's important to take the time to figure out how you feel about it.

### **Questions to Ask Yourself Before Sexting**

Why do I want to sext with my partner?

It's natural to want to please your partner, but how you feel is most important!

What are my boundaries and does my partner respect them?
What do you want to do?

What do you want to do? What don't you want to do?

How much do I trust my partner?

What do you know about their motivations, needs, and ability to support and respect you?

What happens to what I send?

Who do you want to see your sexts? Who do you NOT want to see your sexts?

#### IMPORTANT AGE CONSIDERATION

Some people are too young to engage in sexting. Consult the Age of Consent laws in your region before agreeing to send or receive a nude image.

# Sexting A How-To Guide



#### **Permanent**

You cannot un-send a sext. You are relying on your partner to be trustworthy and respectful.

#### Harassment

You could be harassed or bullied if your images get shared. (Remember this is not your fault.)

### **Revenge Porn**

Images could be used against you or shared without your consent.



#### **Establish Rules**

Agree on what happens to the sexts afterwards. Are they deleted? Password protected?

#### **Ask First**

Ask your partner if you can send new pictures/videos.

#### **Boundaries**

Be clear about what you want and don't want to do.

### What is Revenge Porn?

When people share nude pictures or videos of you without your consent to hurt or embarrass you.

# Sexting A How-To Guide

## **Checking In**

It's important to communicate with your partner to see how they're feeling, especially if you think something is wrong. Check-ins give you the chance to adjust, keep going, or stop sexting.

# When to Check-In

Long periods of silence
Short answers
Attempts to change
the subject

# It's OK to Kill the Mood!

If you're not enjoying yourself anymore, it's okay to stop! Don't worry about anyone else.

# Share Your Feelings

"That was super hot, but I'm feeling a bit overwhelmed. Could we change the subject?"

### 6 Ways to Check-In

Checking in can sometimes feel uncomfortable or awkward, which is normal.

Practice makes perfect! Here are some ways to check in:

- 1. Would you like to slow down?
  - 4. Are you having fun?

- 2. Do you like that?
- 5. Would you like to stop?
- 3. How are you doing over there?
  - 6. What would you like to try?

# Sexting A How-To Guide



## **Nudes**

- 1. Wear what makes you feel confident.
  - 2. Don't show your face.

**Filler** What are you gonna do to me?

Tell me more...

### Ask Before Sending!

"I found the hottest video. [Description of Porn Clip]. Wanna watch it with me?"
