



FEATHERED CLOTHESPIN TURKEY

Lesson of the Day:

Gobble gobble! That's what a turkey says. What does the word gobble mean? It means to take everything and eat it very fast. Should you eat all the food or should you share? We should share with our family and friends. If we have extra, we should share with anyone who needs it.

Materials:

- Brown construction paper (two shades)
- Glue
- Feathers
- Scissors
- Colorful paper
- Googly eyes



Instructions:

1. Discuss the lesson of the day with your students. Talk about what it means to them.
2. Have students trace their hand twice on brown construction paper and cut those hands out.
3. Have students glue those hands together with feathers on top.
4. Have them cut two circles out of different shades of brown construction paper. Glue the smaller one inside the other and glue those on top of the hands/feathers so that the feathers show.
5. Have the students add googly eyes, a triangle beak, and an upside-down heart for a snood.
6. Add clothespin legs.
