



BOOK MAKING

Lesson of the Day:

Everybody has a story to tell, and a life they have lived. No two people's lives or stories are exactly alike. We have to listen to one another to try our best to understand where someone is coming from and what they have to say.



Materials:

- Paper
- Ribbon
- Hole Punch
- Beads
- Markers
- Colored Pencils

Instructions:

1. Discuss the lesson of the day with your students. Talk about what it means to them.
2. Have kids take several sheets of paper and fold them in half. Hole punch the edge.
3. Have the students weave a ribbon through the holes in order to bind the book. They can tie a bow and some beads on the end to keep the binding together.
4. Have students create a cover for their book and fill its pages—either with a story, or pictures and facts from their lives.
5. Give students time to share their stories and books with one another.
