



GROUNDHOG MASK

Lesson of the Day:

People say that if a groundhog in Pennsylvania doesn't see his shadow, that means there will be six more weeks of winter.

Does that sound like something that really happens? Try not to place too much importance on little things and focus on the things that really matter!



Materials:

- Card stock
- Hole punch
- Wooden sticks
- Glue
- Brown, black, white paper
- Brown paint
- String
- Scissors

Instructions:

1. Discuss the lesson of the day with your students. Talk about what it means to them.
2. Have students cut a heart out of the cardstock and paint it brown.
3. When the paint dries, have them add a nose, ears, and teeth cut from construction paper.
4. Have them glue on wooden sticks as whiskers.
5. Tell students to cut the eye holes out of the card stock.
6. Have students punch holes and add string so they can tie their masks onto their faces.
