

CATCH THE BEAD

Lesson of the Day:

When you first try to catch the bead in the cup, it might be a bit difficult. But if you keep trying and working at it, you'll be able to do it! If you practice a lot, you might even start to find it pretty easy. Practicing just about everything will make you better at it! So keep it up! You can do it!

Materials:

- Paper cup
- Pencil
- String
- Hot glue gun



- Decorations
- Glue
- Markers
- Bead



Instructions:

- 1. Discuss the lesson of the day with your students. Talk about what it means to them.
- 2. Have students decorate their cup. They can color it with markers, glue ribbons around it, add sequins or glitter glue... whatever decorations you want to allow them!
- 3. Once they have decorated the cup, punch a hole around the bottom rim and tie the end of the string to it.
- 4. Tie the other end of the string around the bead. Make sure the string is long enough to get into the cup with a decent amount of slack.
- 5. Hot glue the pencil to the center of the bottom of the cup.
- 6. Play and have fun!
