



COMPLIMENT RAINBOWS

Lesson of the Day:

Everybody has things about them that are wonderful. Look for the things that are wonderful about others. Tell your friends how they are great every day. And remind yourself that you are great too! Work on the things you aren't so good at, but don't forget the things about you that are special!



Materials:

- Construction paper
- White paper
- Glitter
- Watercolor paints
- Glue sticks
- Scissors



Instructions:

1. Discuss the lesson of the day with your students. Talk about what it means to them.
2. Have students watercolor a piece of paper with different shades of blue to make a beautiful, rainy sky.
3. Have students write their name on white paper and trace a cloud around it. Have them cut out the cloud.
4. Have students cut out thin rectangles in each color and glue them to the bottom of the cloud. On each stripe of rainbow, have them write something they like about themselves. They can give friends suggestions of what to write.
5. Glue the rainbow and cloud to the watercolor paper.
6. Have them add glitter and other decorations.
