



DOVES OF PEACE

Lesson of the Day:

Empathy is when you think about how other people feel instead of just thinking about yourself.

If everyone in the world had empathy, tried to understand everyone else, and cared about how others feel, the world would be a kinder, more peaceful place.



Materials:

- Light blue construction paper
- White paint
- Black paint
- Green paint
- Yellow or orange paint
- Markers

Instructions:

1. Discuss the lesson of the day with your students. Talk about what it means to them.
2. Have students paint their hand white and place a handprint in the middle of a piece of light blue construction paper. The paper will represent the sky, so color is a little important.
3. Have students add details to their dove, like a beak, feet, eyeballs, and a vine in the dove's mouth. Make sure there are leaves on the vine. Paint is great for these details.
4. Have students write the word "Peace" on the paper with their dove.
