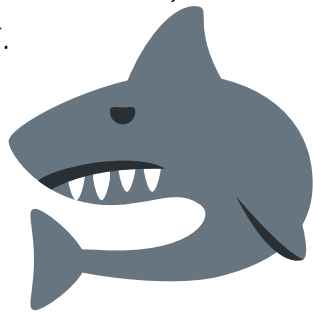




SHARP TOOTHED SHARK HATS

Lesson of the Day:

Even scary things like sharks aren't always so bad. Sometimes if you look beneath the surface of a classmate who scares you, you'll see that on the inside, they're scared too. Everybody has a heart, even if their teeth can hurt.



Materials:

- Blue construction paper
- White paper
- Black construction paper
- Black markers
- Scissors
- Glue

Instructions:

1. Discuss the lesson of the day with your students. Talk about what it means to them.
2. Cut large, somewhat rounded triangles from blue construction paper.
3. Make a strip of paper to go around each student's head.
4. Have students decorate the large triangles to have a shark face- glue down a large piece of black construction paper as the mouth and draw eyes.
5. Have students cut many small white triangles and glue them around the outside of the black mouth, with the triangle points pointing toward the inside as teeth.
6. Affix the shark head to the headband paper strip.
