



NATIONAL WEAR RED SCARVES

Lesson of the Day:

Keep yourself warm in the cold- if you're going through a hard time try to find something warm you can hold on to, something happy you can do to keep the sadness and anger from getting to be too much. If someone you know is going through a hard time, try to be that warm, happy thing for them.



Materials:

- Red paper
- Yarn
- Double-sided tape
- Markers
- Hole punch



Instructions:

1. Discuss the lesson of the day with your students. Talk about what it means to them.
2. Give each student a long strip of red paper.
3. Have them use markers to decorate their scarf using whatever pattern they want- stripes, chevrons, hearts, etc.
4. Have students punch holes along each short end of their scarf.
5. Allow them to tie whatever colors of yarn they want to the end to complete their scarf.
6. Use double stick tape to twist their scarves and stick them together.
