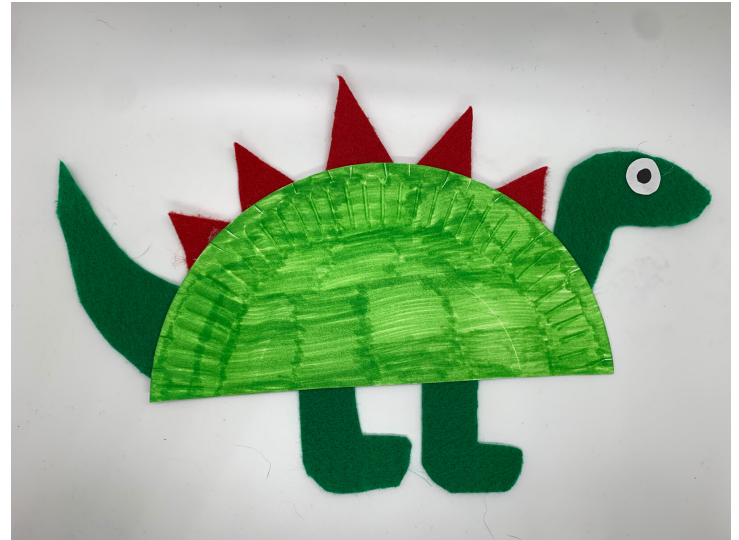




# PAPER PLATE DINOSAUR

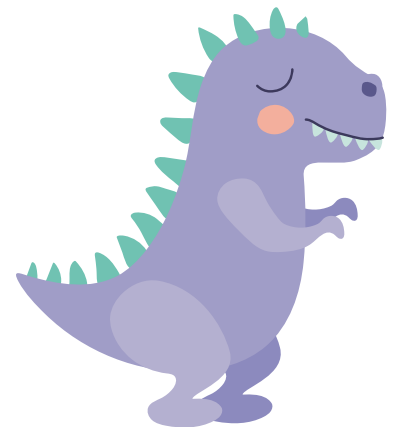
## Lesson of the Day:

Dinosaurs have been gone a long time. Were there people alive when dinosaurs were alive? No, but we still found a lot of their bones and other things that tell us about them. We remember them as being huge animals, some scary, some gentle and kind. When you are spending time with people try to think about how you want them to remember you when you are gone. Do you want them to remember you as kind or mean?



## Materials:

- Toilet roll
- Construction paper
- Tape
- Scissors
- Tin foil
- Markers
- Tissue paper



## Instructions:

1. Discuss the lesson of the day with your students. Talk about what it means to them.
2. Have students cut a paper plate in half and share it with a friend. Have them color the plate the color of the dinosaur's body.
3. Have students cut out legs, a tail, a head, and any other body parts they want (wings, spikes, etc.) from whatever color felt they want.
4. Have students cut out a circle from white paper for the eye.
5. Have them glue it all together and add details if they want.
