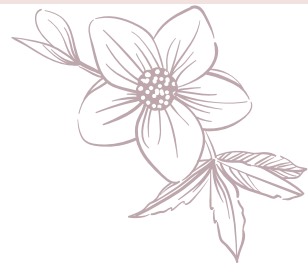


50 Quotes To Think on When Setting Goals

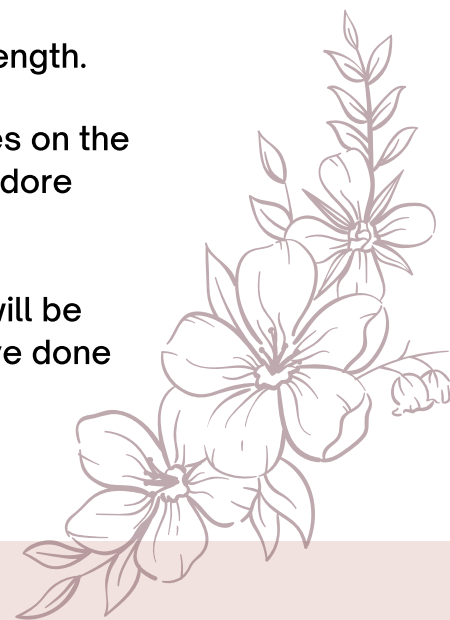
