Tunstall medical alarm



Tunstall's personal medical alarms employ the latest communications technology and will work on digital, VoIP, and GSM networks. Our alarms provide two-way,

hands-free communication with our 24 hour local response centre or alternatively can be programmed to alert an onsite carer.

iVi fall detector



The Tunstall iVi fall detector pendant can be worn on the belt or around the neck. It is an intelligent fall detector that can automatically identify a fall and alert the response centre or an onsite carer.

The user can also manually activate or cancel the alert.

Pressure mat



A Tunstall pressure mat could be placed on the floor by the resident's bed to determine if they are active in the home and also to notify carers or the response centre

that the resident has gotten up or has not returned to bed by a certain time.

Property Exit Sensor



The Tunstall property exit sensor provides real time alerts when a resident has walked out of the home and not returned within a preset time, or simply left the door

wide open. This allows quick action to be taken to find the resident and return them to safety or encourage them to shut the door.

Temperature extreme sensor
